CENSUS-BIRTH: 1830 US Census for Ashe Co., NC placed his birth at 1760-1770.

BIRTH-DEATH-SPOUSE-CHILDREN: Mrs. Mae Schokey, of Pound, Wise, VA, 1959 to Janet Austin Curtis, AFAOA genealogist, Virginia B Notebook, 323.

RESIDENCE: In the Wythe Co., VA Tax Book, Bartholomew was taxed in 1793.

CENSUS-CHILDREN: It would appear from the 1820 US Census for Ashe Co., NC that all 13 of Bartholomew's and Anna's children were still at home, but the census form listed two age groups in which one duplicated that already listed (i.e. the 16-18 age group is a duplication of those in the 16-26 age group - this occurring only when males between the ages of 16-18 were in the household). The 1820 census, p 3 read as follows: Bat Auston, 3 males under 10 years; 3 males 10-16 years; 1 male 16-18 (this one would also be included in the following age group): 3 males 16-26; 1 male over 45; 1 female under 10 years old; 1 female 10-16; 1 female 10-16; 1 female 16-25 and 1 female over 45 years old. The son that had already left home by the 1820 census was probably William or Isaiah. Jesse and Andrew both married after the 1820 census.

CENSUS-RESIDENCE: 1850 US Census for Grayson Co., VA, District 19, Household #974-974, p 230 (enumerated 8 Oct 1850) lists Anna widow, and son John.

CENSUS-RESIDENCE: 1860 US Census for the Elk Creek Post Office District, Alleghany Co., NC, Household #31-29 (enumerated 20 Jun 1860) lists Ann Austin, 80, midwife, born VA, living alone.

DEATH: Bartholomew Austin died around 1841 at Cumberland Gap, KY, en-route to/or from visiting relatives in KY. The source for Bartholomew's death was word of mouth conversation between E. Ray Austin, Ruth Marshall Austin, and Ann Dawson Thomas, of Amelia, VA, in the late 1980's or early 1990's. This information was passed on to Ann previously, but she doesn't remember her source. NOTE: Anna Reeves was listed as a widow in the 1850 US Census (see above), so Bartholomew obviously died before 8 Oct 1850. ACTION: Death date & place must be verified.

He married **Margaret Douglas** about 1834 in Grayson Co., VA. She was born 24 Mar 1818 in Ashe Co., NC. Margaret was the daughter of John Douglas and Margaret Cox She died 19 Jan 1895 in Pound, Wise, Virginia, and was buried in Austin Cemetery, Pound, Wise, VA.

BIOGRAPHY: In a ca. 1934 article published in "The Southside Virginian", Vol. VI, #28, Jun 1983 issue, Norton, VA, on p 56, David Washington Austin (Jack's brother) related the story of his brother's Civil War Experience: "Jesse Austin's oldest son Jack was taking a load of wool to the carding machine at Wise, VA during the Civil War (1861-1865). He came upon a group of Rebel Soldiers under the command of Ben Caudel. They invited him to come back and spend the night in camp, which he did. During the night, he awoke with a definite conviction that the enemy was advancing upon their group. He arose and went through the camp, waking all the soldiers. However, he didn't convince them and to save himself, he went out on a hill to watch as daylight came." "In the early morning he spied a party of soldiers riding along the foot of the hill. They were dressed in Rebel clothing and thinking they were his friends, went down the hill to them. He had been right in his convictions that the enemy was coming. These men were so dressed in order to deceive the Rebels. Jack was taken prisoner along with all the others to whom he had given warning. All of them were taken to the prison camp at Fort Douglas, IL, where several contracted yellow fever. A few lived to return and tell the tale, but Jack died of the fever." "Sometime during Jack's imprisonment he wrote the history of his life. This, a testament and a Hymn Book, he gave to a friend and asked them to be sent to his mother. These possessions were handed down from his mother to his youngest sister Jerusha Austin." Researcher's note: In this 1934 article, David Washington Austin, said that he believed the history of Jack's life, his testament and Hymn Book were in Jerry Bryant's possession. He did not identify specifically who Jerry Bryant was (is), but he appears to be related to their aunt Lucinda (Bryant), wife of Andrew Austin.

BIOGRAPHY: In a ca. 1934 article published in "The Southside Virginian", Vol. VI, #28, Jun 1983 issue, Norton, VA, on p 55, David Washington Austin (Jesse's son) related the story of his family's travels: Two years after leaving Grayson Co., VA for Ashe Co., NC, the Jesse Austin family were ready to move on to newer country. On 15 Nov 1855, Jesse Austin gathered together his family and all his earthly possessions and made ready to head for the mountains of Kentucky. There were 29 in the company, 12 in Jesse Austin's family, 12 in John Poplin's family, Jim Ashly, Abe Gooch, Enoch Cox, Jess Parsons, and Bets Howell. They had 5 wagons pulled by 2 yokes of oxen and 3 teams of horses. They also had two other horses and five head of cattle, four milk cows and one heifer. They drove through Washington Co., VA near Iron Mountain and into Wise Co., VA where Jesse Austin met one of his mother's cousins Terrial Cox, who had come to that part of the country some time before. Cox persuaded Jesse and his family to remain with him until Spring. This was on 20 Dec 1855. So they rented a little house and lived in Wise Co., VA until March of 1856 when they moved to Elkhorn Creek on the same bottoms where Mudtown is now. They lived there until the outbreak of the Civil War, 1861, and then moved back to Wise Co., VA. They settled in the south of the mountain in what is now called White Oak. There they pioneered in a woodland that Jesse had purchased previously.

RESIDENCE-LOCALE: "Family Burying Grounds of Wise Co., VA" by James Taylor Adams, Southwest Virginian, Norton, VA (no year, but probably the late 1930's) . "The settlement around the forks of The Pound, now generally known as Austin's Store, was called Donkey in the olden days and was a rendezvous for bad men. I have heard old citizens say that around 1900 the place bore such an evil reputation that travelers on the old Pound Gap Turnpike (now US 23) would go out of their way and around it. One day, eleven years ago, One-Eyed Dock Mullins told me in Austin Store, in the presence of George Fields Austin, that he had compiled a list of 51 killings that had occurred within a radius of four miles of where he stood."

MARRIAGE-QUESTION: Researcher notes from Ruth Marshall Austin: NC Marriage Records (1741-1868) on microfiche at Greensboro, NC Public Library record only two Nancy Austins that married in Ashe Co. during the appropriate time frame: 1) A Nancy Austin married Andrew J. Warden on 22 May 1856, marriage bond dated 15 May 1856, witness was Robert Gambill and was performed by Caleb Osborne, J.P. 2) A Nancy Austin married Jonathan Howel on 25 Nov 1857, marriage bond dated 24 Nov 1857 witness was John A. Jones who also performed the ceremony. I do not know if either or both of these Nancy Austins are the one born in 1835 to Andrew Austin, but with marriages being performed in 1856 and 1857 what was Nancy doing at home with her parents under the name of Nancy Austin when the 1860 US Census was taken on 15 Aug 1860?

If perhaps this is the marriage of Mary Austin, daughter of Andrew Austin, she would have married at age 14.

Before leaving I made Lavina (David's fiance) a promise to return and though greatly tempted not to, I kept my promise." "We traveled on horseback having three horses. Rather than double up I walked a greater part of the way, we made the trip in 5 days of travel but were on the road longer. The end of our first night we were on another days journey in the early dawn of a cold November morning. We went up Frying Pan into Sandlick and Russell Co. VA. We managed to reach the home of another acquaintance of father's Lige Ferrel's. We removed the saddles from our horses and waited." "A young man passing by told us Mr. Ferrel was at a corn shucking with his Negro ex-slaves. Very soon Mr. Ferrel and his wife came home and there we spent the second night. He lived this side of Clinch River in Russell Co. VA. After much effort crossing the Clinch River the next day we arrived in New Garden, VA in Russell Co. in the evening, at one of my father's sisters - Prudy Austin." "We stayed two nights there - rested and re-shod our horses. After having traveled across 3 mountains Clinch, Winding Stair, and House and Barn, we came to Dave Ellison's in Washington Co. VA just this side of King's Salt works where a serious battle took place during the Civil War. The

next day we crossed 3 forks of Holston River and night found us on Comas Creek in the Iron Mountains of Washington Co. VA. The name of the man with whom we stayed that night has left my memory." "Another days' travel brought us into Grayson Co. VA at noon. We stopped with Matthew Perry and had dinner. Then traveling up Saddle Creek and Fox Creek we came to Steve Ward's, a cousin to mother. We spent the night with them. By evening of the next day we arrived at Jack Warden's who had married Nannie Austin, a cousin of my father. They were living in the same house that we moved from. It had been 20 years since we moved away, but not the smallest improvement had been made in the old log house with only one room, one door, and no windows." "Our visits in those days were few and far between so we made them count. We spent a few days more than a month with our people. I was only a small child when we had moved away but with father, mother and Tilda, I felt as well known as they."

"Aunt Prudy Austin from New Garden on Clinch River in Russell County had just been to Wise County to see her mother, Anne Austin, and was returning home. She was worried on leaving her mother, knowing she would never see her again.

Riding so slowly on a horse and a side-saddle at that is tiresome. Soon Aunt Prudy became tired and got down to walk a piece. She left her shawl, a fine homespun one, with red and yellow stripes running checker-board fashion, lying across the saddle. hadn't gone more than a half mile when she missed her shawl. Jess Austin, her nephew, was going a little way with her for company. When she missed her shawl, Jess jumped on the horse to go back for it. Very soon he met an man and his son, Old John and Vint Wright.

"Have you found a shawl?" he asked. "No," replied the two, "but we met two men and they might have picked the shawl up." Jess turned back to Aunt Prudy, taking the men at their word. Aunt Prudy went on home.

A short time after that, this particular Wright family were planning to move away to Little Sandy, Kentucky. Adeline Brickey Wright came from Scott to pay them a visit before they went away. They were showing two fine shawls they had bought for their two daughters, Liza and Lizza. Adeline asked, "Why didn't you buy Cindy a shawl?" They replied, "We have a good shawl for Cindy that came by slight of hand." As it happened another daughter-in-law, Rene, who was a very honest woman, was by and heard the remark about Cindy's shawl. She remembered the missing shawl and told her Aunt Nancy Wright about it. Aunt Nancy told Margaret Austin, Pappy's mother about it. Everyone suspicious it was Aunt Prudy's shawl.

Pappy's mother planned to have her daughter Anne slip the shawl away while she had old Mrs. Wright and everybody's attention attracted. Anne was to put it on for petticoat. She succeeded in getting it out of the hidden box, but her courage failed as she couldn't do it. They came back home and Pappy's mother said the plan did not work and asked, "Who will go for the shawl?" Now that they had seen the shawl and knew it was Aunt Prudy's, they could dare to be a little braver. Pappy said, "I'll go get it."

We wonder at their eagerness to get the shawl back again. Sixty years ago a shawl was a very stylish piece of apparel for women and a good shawl was valued. They were enormous, sometimes half as large as a blanket. Most of them were homemade and that took much time and labor. But outside the value of the shawl, was the desire not to be out-witted by others. It was a sort of game to try to be more cunning than the other fellow.

So Pappy set out to recover the stolen shawl. He went first to Devil John Wright's, a nephew to this old John, and told him about the concealed shawl. Pappy's plan was to go down and get it openly and prove by law, if necessary, whose shawl it was. Devil John said, "No, that won't do. They'll swear lies to beat you and you'll have to pay the cost. They stole it, now you steal it."

He took Devil John at his word and together they made their plan. Pappy took Devil John up behind him and they rode to old John's. Devil John, presumably had come to get some medicine for a sick child and when he started back urged Pappy to go back with him. However, Pappy decided he'd spend the night with Joel, one of the boys, since they were soon to move away.

That night they had made a bed on the floor for him and another boy who was staying that night. Pappy had spotted the box with the shawl before dark, but before he could get to it, it was necessary to walk between two beds and in one of those were old John and his wife. As soon as everything had been still awhile and Pappy thought it safe, he crept out of bed and got the shawl out of the box. About the time Pappy got half-way to the door, the old man fetched a big cough and Pappy thought he was caught sure. He wasn't awake though and he tiptoed out of the house with the shawl under his arm.

It was in the fall of the year and the ground was frosty, but Pappy went several paces from the house barefoot and hid the shawl under the roots of a tree. He hurried back to the house and found the old man had gone out to the barn to see about his horses. He went back to bed though and no one was the wiser for the night raid.

Early next morning, Pappy made his excuses and went home by Devil John's to tell him of the success. The shawl was sent immediately to Aunt Prudy in Russell and it tickled her in the sleeve to hear how they had outsharped old man Wright and got her shawl.

This and other scrapes won for Pappy the names, "Old Tonquer" and "Bull Dog". "
