734-1. **Moses Austin** was perhaps born 1765-1775, had a son Isaac Austin b. on 17 December 1791 in Dutchess County, New York. Isaac Austin died 28 March 1871 in Brighton, Ontario, Canada. Seeking anything on Moses.

734-2. **Cynthia Austin** was born in 1782, most likely in Washington County, New York. She married in 1803 at Cambridge, Washington County, to Joshua Easton Jr. She died on 25 August 1869 in Castile, New York. Her nine children were Peter, Joshua, Edward, John, Slocum, Elizabeth, Lorenzo, Stephen, and Waldron Easton. Seek information on Cynthia Austin's parents, or any other type of information pertaining to her family.

734-3. **Samuel Arthur Austin** was born 1 August 1856, he married Sarah Elizabeth Bentley who was born on 25 November 1857. Samuel died on 20 December 1931, Sarah died 6 April 1937. They had ten children: Texas Austin b. 24 October 1878 d. 31 December 1904; William Henry Austin b. 12 October 1881 d. 14 December 1953 m. Susan Exer Jeffares b. 25 July 1879 d. 19 May 1963; Thomas Lemuel Austin b. on 15 November 1888 d. on 16 March 1961; Lihu E. Austin b. 17 March 1885 d. 18 May 1893; Trellis May Austin b. 8 May 1886 d. 28 April 1899; Jim D. Austin b. 14 May 1888 d. 12 November 1957 m.

734-4. **Nancy Melvira Austin** was born 8 January 1827 in Shelby County, Illinois. She was married on 7 January 1848 in Shelby County to Edward Reed, son of Moses Reed. They had a son Moses born on 12 March 1858 in Shelby County. Nancy died on 4 February 1901 in Benton County, Arkansas. Seeking Nancy's ancestry.

734-5. **Eliza Austin** was born circa 1798 in New York (per 1850 and 1860 Illinois census). She married circa 1815 in New York to Knight Ramsdell, born in 1795 in Whitestown, Oneida County, New York. They resided in Ellisburg, Jefferson County, New York (per 1830 and 1840 census) before moving to McHenry County, Illinois. Eliza died in May 1877 in Huntley, Grafton Twp. in McHenry County. Their son James Van Rensselaer Ramsdell, was born 29 March 1820 in New Hartford, New York. He was of Ellisburg when he married on 30 August 1841 in Sandy Creek, New York, to Cynthia Naomi Snow.
